



## **\$500 PRIZE ESTABLISHED FOR MARIO SAVIO STUDENT ACTIVIST AWARD WINNER**

In 1997 the Sonoma chapter established the Mario Savio Student Activist Award to recognize a student attending a school in Sonoma County who has shown a personal commitment to civil liberties, human rights and social justice. This award is given to recognize and encourage our community's student activists engaged in the struggle to build a more humane and just society. The chapter will reward the winning student \$500.

Nominations are now being accepted for the award which will be presented at our 2011 Awards Celebration and Annual Dinner.

Nominees should have been engaged in activism for social change, promoting values of civil liberties, human rights, or social justice, acted within the context of an organization, a social movement, or a community effort and be considered by others as an inspirational leader or motivating force.
